## **Photo Tip**

Recently we found ourselves at the Bunya Mountains surrounded by some of Australia's wild birds, but the task at hand is still very difficult. Here are some of the ideas we put into practice to capture our shots.

The first problem is gaining the birds confidence. You can't drive into the parking areas and expect to be shooting great bird pictures straight away. Look for where the birds are and get yourself settled close by. These birds are wild, but they are more used to visitors at National Parks and places of interest.

Get your camera ready, sit tight and have a little patience. The birds will slowly return to the place you first saw them and now you can grab some shots.

Use your continuous or burst shooting mode, because you will have many failures. Long lenses will have a shallow depth of field and the birds move their heads so fast. A centimetre one way or the other is enough to make the birds head out of focus, so shoot loads and you will be successful.

Below is the female Blue Satin Bower Bird, not very blue, but then that is made up for by the male. This shot is full frame so it is possible with patience to capture some frame filling shots of high quality.



Below is the Male Blue Satin Bower Bird. It looks black at times, but a little light and it glows electric blue.
